AMENDING SECTION 75 AND SECTION 76 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 18-11 ALSO KNOWN AS THE "GENERAL TRIAS CHILD AND YOUTH **INCORPORATING** ADDITIONAL CODE" WHEREBY WELFARE COMPOSITIONS IN THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (CCPC) AND BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (BCPC); AND INCLUDING ADDITIONAL PROVISION STRENGTHENING THE BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (BCPC) IN THE 33 BARANGAYS OF THE CITY BY PROVIDING INCENTIVES THROUGH THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE MOST CHILD FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARDS.

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional compositions in the City Council for the Protection of Children (CCPC) and Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC) to further promote and protect the welfare and rights of children in the City;

WHEREAS, the City Government aims to strengthen the functionality of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC) in ensuring the development and protection of children by providing incentives through the institutionalization of the Most Child Friendly Barangay Awards;

WHEREAS, the Most Child Friendly Barangay Awards are granted to deserving barangays in recognition of their vital role in the sustained promotion of children's rights to survival, development, protection and participation as well as in ensuring a child-friendly governance;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member J-M Vergel M. Columna duly seconded by SP Member Isagani L. Culanding,

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panglungsod, that:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE - For the purposes of this Ordinance, Section 75 and Section 76 of the General Trias Child and Youth Welfare Code are hereby amended to be read as follows:

I. AMENDMENTS ON SECTION 75

Section 75. COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (CCPC).

- A. The CCPC shall be composed of the following but is not limited to:
 - 1. City Mayor
 - 2. Sangguniang Panlungsod Member
 - 3. City Planning and Development Coordinator
 - 4. City Social Welfare and Development Officer
 - 5. City Health Officer
 - 6. Schools Division Superintendent
 - 7. City Public Employment and Service Officer
 - 8. City Legal Officer
 - 9. Sangguniang Kabataan Federation (SKF) President
 - 10. Three (3) Non-Government Organization (NGO) Representatives
 - 11. Four (4) Child Representatives
 - 12. Liga ng mga Barangay (LNB) President
 - 13. Member of the City Finance Committee
 - 14. Representative of Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)
 - 15. Representative of the Philippine National Police (PNP)
 - 16. Representative of the Public Information Office

The membership of the representatives coming from the nongovernment organizations, private sectors, and agencies/offices outside of the City Government shall commence upon their acceptance of the invitation from the City Mayor.

The members may designate a permanent alternate member to represent in the meetings and activities.

The four (4) child representatives shall be selected through an election during the conduct of the Children's Congress. Representatives from different sectors including the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and Intersex (LGBTQI) and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) is required. The four child representatives shall be assigned to the four committees of the Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) – Committees on Survival, Protection, Development and Participation.

- B. Duties and Functions of the CCPC:
 - Formulate the City's plan of action for children, incorporating projects and programs needing assistance submitted by their constituent barangays; and ensure the integration of these plans into the City Development Plan;
 - 2. Monitor and review the implementation of the City and barangay plans;

- 3. Submit quarterly status reports on the plan implementation to the Philippine Council for the Protection of Children (PCPC) through the City Planning Development Office;
- 4. Promptly address issues and concerns affecting children and youth in their areas;
- 5. Advocate the passage of relevant child and youth protective ordinances;
- 6. Advocate increased support and resource allocation for children's programs and projects from the Local Government Unit of General Trias and secure resources for the same from the other sources:
- 7. Provide technical assistance to community-based frontline workers through the conduct of capacity building and human resources activities; and
- 8. Prepare contingency measures to protect children and their families in crisis brought about by the natural and human-made calamities.

Secretariat support should be lodged with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) which shall be responsible for the documentation of proceedings of meetings and preparation of reports and other necessary documents as needed by the Council.

II. AMENDMENTS ON SECTION 76

Section 76. CREATION AND STRENGTHENING OF BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (BCPC). The barangay shall create a Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC), and the composition of which shall be determined by the former depending on the needs and circumstances in the area.

A. The BCPC shall have the following functions:

- 1. Foster education of every child and young people in the barangay, assuring that every child should have at least finished secondary education;
- 2. Encourage proper performance of the duties of parents and provide learning opportunities on the adequate rearing of children and on positive parent-child relationship;
- 3. Report all cases of child abuse to the proper authorities:
- Protect and assist abandoned, maltreated and abused children and facilitate their cases filed against child abusers;
- 5. Prevent child labor in their area and protect working children (e.g. from abuse and exploitation)
- 6. Take step, prevent juvenile delinquency and assist children with behavioral problems so they can get expert advice;
- 7. Adopt measures to promote the health and nutrition of children;
- 8. Promote the opening and maintenance of playgrounds, reading and learning center, day care centers and other services necessary for child and youth welfare;

- 9. Secure the cooperation of organization devoted to the welfare of children and coordinate their activities;
- 10. Promote wholesome entertainment in the community;
- 11. Assist parents whenever necessary in securing expert guidance counselling from the proper governmental or private welfare agencies;
- 12. Advocate the passage of child-friendly barangay ordinances in response to child-related issues and concerns;
- 13. Prepare the barangay plans of action for children which address the needs of children in the community and ensure their integration into the Barangay Development Plan and implementation by the barangay; and
- 14. Submit quarterly barangay accomplishment reports on the implementation of the plan to the CCPC.
- B. The BCPC shall be composed of the following but is not limited to:
 - 1. Chairperson: Punong Barangay
 - 2. Co-chairperson (to be elected by BCPC members)
 - 3. Barangay Kagawad (Women & Children's Desk)
 - 4. Nutrition Scholar
 - 5. Barangay Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) Worker (Day Care Centers)
 - 6. Health Nurse/Midwife (Public Health Centers)
 - 7. Department of Education Principal/Teacher-in-Charge/Guidance Counselor (Elementary and High School)
 - 8. Chief Barangay Tanod/Police (Community Security Force)
 - 9. Sangguniang Kabataan Chairperson
 - 10. Four (4) Child Representatives from Children's Group
 - 11. Barangay Violence Against Women and their Children (VAWC) Desk Officer
 - 12. Parents-Teachers Association (PTA) President or his/her representative
 - 13. Non-Government Organization (NGO) Representatives (includes Interfaith Groups)
 - 14. People's Organization (PO) Representatives
 - 15. Other sectors or groups of children involved in children's welfare.
- C. In strengthening the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC), incentives through the institutionalization of the Most Child Friendly Barangay Awards shall be provided.

This section is promulgated in order to:

1. Motivate the various barangays of the City to adopt measures that will protect children's rights;

- 2. Encourage the Sangguniang Barangays of the City to enact ordinances, resolutions and executive orders for the welfare of children;
- 3. Achieve improved infant survival rates by ensuring that adequate health and nutrition programs are accessible to young children from prenatal period throughout the early childhood years;

4. Ensure the children's rights to survival, development, protection and participation;

5. Eliminate all psychological and physical abuse, neglect, cruelty and emotional maltreatment; and

 Eliminate all forms of child trafficking, child prostitution and other sexual abuse, and forced labor among others.

COVERAGE. This section shall cover all of the 33 barangays of the City and shall focus on the effectiveness and innovativeness of their respective programs on the protection and promotion of children's rights and welfare.

THE MOST CHILD FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARD. The Most Child Friendly Barangay Award is hereby established to be conferred to barangays which have met the criteria and conditions prescribed in this section, as confirmed and validated by the Awards Committee comprised herein.

CRITERIA. The Most Child Friendly Barangay Award shall be conferred to outstanding barangays which have gained the highest points in the following criteria:

- d. Confer with the City Mayor on the outcome of the report including their suggested recommendations; and
- e. Submit report to the Provincial Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force (IMTF), and copy furnished the DILG City Office.

The City Search for the Most Functional Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC) shall be conducted every year and the schedule of evaluation shall be set by the evaluating team within a strategic period prior to the date of awarding and recognition during the Children's Month Celebration held on the month of November of every year.

RECOGNITIONS AND AWARDS. The awards for the City Search for the Most Functional Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPS) are as follows:

These awards shall be exclusively used for the programs, projects or activities beneficial to the children of the winning barangay. The recognition and awarding ceremony shall be scheduled within a strategic period determined by the evaluation team.

Winner for three consecutive years shall be declared Hall of Famer. On the fourth year, a Hall of Famer shall be assessed and evaluated for sustainability and will be given a Plaque of Sustainability. After five years, the Hall of Famer can again join the search.

APPROPRIATION. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this section shall be charged out of the Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) budget.

SECTION 2. SEPERABILITY CLAUSE – If any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain valid and enforceable.
