GRANTING CASH INCENTIVES TO INDIVIDUALS, PAIRED OR GROUPS, AND COACHES/TRAINERS EXCELLING IN SPORTS, SKILLS, AND ACADEMIC COMPETITIONS; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Article II Section 17 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;

WHEREAS, Article XIV Section 2 (3) of the same fundamental law also provides that the State shall establish and maintain among other concerns, a system of incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, especially to the underprivileged;

WHEREAS, Article XIV Section 19 (1) of the same fundamental law further provides that the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, aimed at boosting the self-esteem of all the and academic participants in their respective competitions as well as distinguishing their accomplishments and sacrifices for bringing honor to the City of General Trias in the provincial, regional, national and international tournaments; the City Government deemed it right to provide them cash incentives;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Reienel R. Ferrer duly seconded by SP Member Vivencio Q. Lozares, Jr.,

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "CASH INCENTIVES FOR SPORTS, SKILLS, AND ACADEMIC COMPETITION WINNERS, COACHES, AND TRAINERS ORDINANCE".

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND COVERAGE - Individual, group, coaches, trainers who may be entitled for the cash incentives granted by this Ordinance shall be those who have placed Top Three (3) in their respective levels of competitions.

SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is hereby declared a policy of the City Government of General Trias to extend cash incentives to deserving individual/s, group, coaches and trainers for bringing honor to the City in various legitimate competitions in the fields of academics, skills, and sports competitions.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS - As used in this ordinance, the following terms or phrases shall be construed to mean:

- a. Academic Competitions refers to all academic related competitions in the regional, national, international, or worldwide levels duly administered by national government agencies conducted within the country while competition in the international and worldwide must have been approved by the concerned national government agencies;
- b. Skills Competitions refers to the diverse skills competitions that focus on providing recognition to the talents and abilities of achievers from any technical vocational schools and training centers. competitions must be duly permitted by Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA).

For Purposes of this Ordinance, the following are the Levels of Skills Competition:

- a. Regional Level,
- b. National Level,
- ASEAN Level, and
- d. World/International Level;
- c. Sports Competitions refers to all sports competitions organized or permitted by the government nongovernment agencies such as Department Education (DepEd), Philippine Olympic Committee (POC), Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), or other Local Government Units (LGUs).

Sports competitions may be categorized as:

- Regional Sports Competitions include, but not limited to the following:
 - a. Regional Athletic Meet,
 - Batang Pinoy Leagues, and b.
 - c. Special Olympics,
- National Sports Competitions include, but not limited to the following:
 - Palarong Pambansa,
 - Philippine National Youth Games (Batang Pinoy),
 - c. National Open,
 - d. National Games, and
 - Special Olympics,

SECTION 5. QUALIFICATIONS

Grantees

- Bonafide resident of the City of General Trias for at 1. least one (1) year or residing in the City in case of in-school-youth (ISY) for at least two (2) years and must have duly represented the City of General Trias in the competitions they had participated;
- Have notified the City Incentive Committee through writing of his/her participation, and that he/she is an official representative of the City or the country in a specific competition before the for actual competition the purpose documentation officially representing the City of General Trias;
- 3. Have submitted all necessary documents stating that he/she is the authorized representative of the City of General Trias, participated and secured the First (1st), Second (2nd) or Third (3rd) Place or Gold, Silver, and Bronze medal in an authorized competition in the regional, national, international and worldwide levels; and
- 4. Have been verified by the City Incentive Committee that the grantees have provided all requirements in this Ordinance through an appropriate resolution of the City Incentive Committee;

Coaches/trainers:

For regional and national competitions - he/she must be a Filipino citizen, with authentic certification from appropriate authority or agency, and the official coach or trainer of the grantee for not less than six (6) months from the actual competition;

- For international level of sports competitions must be a Filipino citizen, member of the national coaches and trainers pool, recognized and accredited by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) and represented the country as official coach or trainer to national athletes in international competitions; and
- For international level of academic competitions must be a Filipino citizen, with authentic certification from appropriate authority or agency, and the official coach or trainer of the grantee for not less than six (6) months from the actual competition.

SECTION 6. CITY INCENTIVE COMMITTEE - A City Incentive Committee is hereby created, primarily tasked to screen applicants based on the minimum qualifications stated in this Ordinance.

The City Incentive Committee is composed of the following:

- Chairperson: City Mayor
- Vice Chairperson: City Vice Mayor
- Members:
 - 1. SP Member Chair on Committee on Sports and Youth Development,
 - 2. SP Member Chair on Committee on Education,
 - 3. SP Member Chair on Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriation,
 - 4. SP Member Chair on Committee on Commerce, Trade and Industry (in case of skills excellence award),
 - 5. City Administrator,
 - 6. City Budget Officer,
 - 7. Representative from the Department of Education General Trias City Division Office (in case of Elementary and High School students),
 - 8. Representative from Colleges in the City (in case of college students),
 - 9. City Sports Development Officer, and
 - 10. Local Youth Development Officer.

The Office of the City Planning and Development Coordinator shall serve as the Secretariat of the City Incentive Committee.

SECTION 7. AMOUNT OF CASH INCENTIVES

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY - The Office of the City Mayor through the City Incentive Committee and other offices or personnel as maybe deputized by the Local Chief Executive shall implement and formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain valid and enforceable.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules, and regulations or part thereof where provisions are in conflict or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting at three (3) conspicuous places in the City of General Trias.
